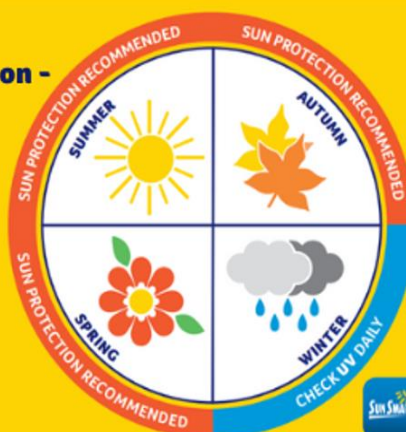

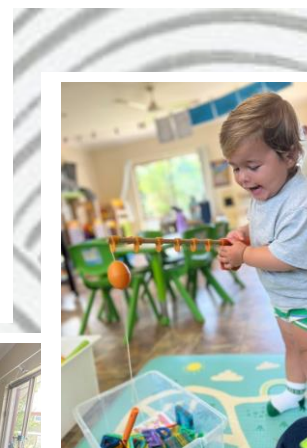

educators: relationships come first, follow the child not the plan, keep it simple, be kind to yourself, reflect often, value play, communicate with families and celebrate the little wins.

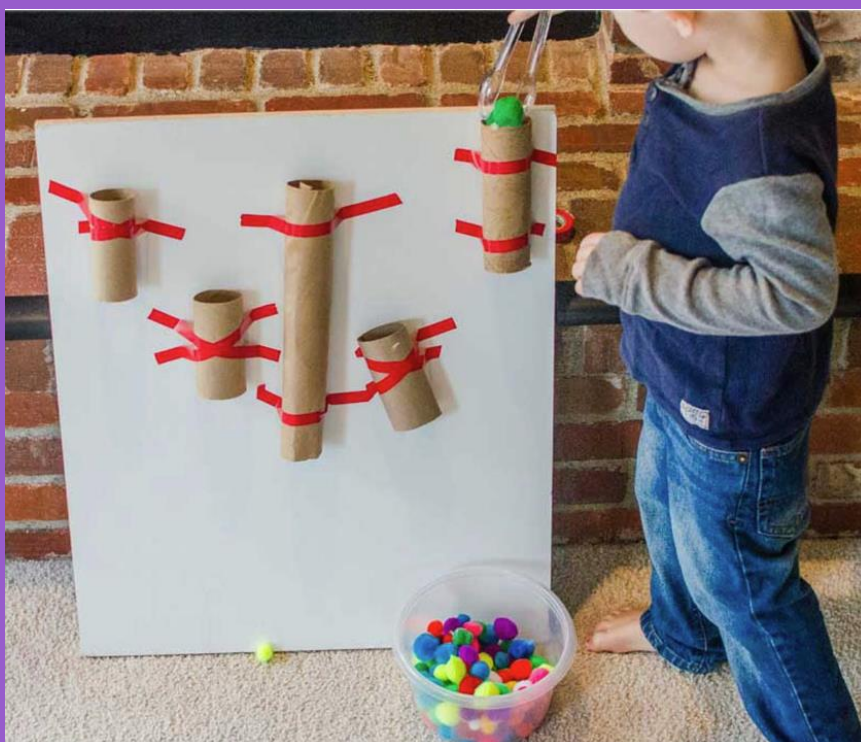
Am I happy for other educators to reach and connect

with me: I am always happy for other educators to reach out, connect, and share ideas.

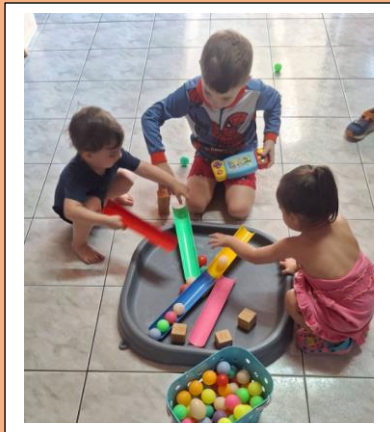


Sustainable activity – Pom Pom Drop!
